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## Exhibitor Information

- Dogs must be leashed or crated when not working. There is crating available in the front room of the site. Please make sure your crate is safe and secure as the dogs may be highly excited. Soft crates **NOT** recommended.
- Electronic collars and/or devices, head halters, or flexi leads are not allowed in the building. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited lip martingale and single piece slip collars/ leads are allowed. Harnesses are allowed.
- Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced. Dogs may **NOT** be brought to the gate in any disallowed collars or on a Flexi lead. Dogs **MUST** run "naked", i.e. without collar/harness.
- Dogs will be run in height order from Small to Large with dogs being handled by the same person separated into differently staged groups.
- Bitches in season (BIS) will run at the end of the class. BIS must compete in panties specifically designed for the purpose of preventing/containing seasonal discharges. BIS will be crated in a separate area isolated from other dogs, and separate potty area will be designated. Owners of BIS must inform the trial chair of their status as soon as possible; prior to the event if known, or the morning of the trial if the BIS comes into season that day, so that run orders can be adjusted.
- Refunds are available for injured, deceased dogs. Notification must be made to the trial chairman/secretary within 30 minutes before the start of the test.
- It is suggested that exhibitors bring their own chairs. There are numerous fast food restaurants within 3 mile.
